Health & Safety Information and Risk Consent Form

This workshop is designed to be as safe and enjoyable as possible for most individuals. There are, however, some risks associated with the activity. Due to the use of glass, lead solder and intense heat in this workshop, it is not advisable for:

- Pregnant persons
- Those with any types of developmental restrictions which may hinder motor control
- Those with little or no fine motor control.

Risks associated with this activity:

- Glass is sharp, can break and splinter. When cutting or grinding glass, there is a risk of cuts and a small chance of airborne splinters. Safety goggles or other eye protection is recommended. Finger protectors can be worn when grinding. Sweep splinters away using the brush and dustpan provided. Tie back long hair; do not wear dangling jewellery near the grinder.
- The solder contains lead. Do not breathe the fumes. A mask can be worn. Lead-free solder available at modest extra cost.
- Soldering irons become very hot and there is a risk of burns from both the iron and the molten solder. Only pick up the soldering iron by its handle, never by the metal tip. Always return the iron to its stand, never on the table. Use the mats provided. Let solder and artwork cool before handling or washing it.
